

**Directors of the Summer Sessions
Policy on Spouses and Partners/ Joint Directorships**

I. Spouses/Partners and dependents

Spouses and partners of Summer Session directors are welcome at the School and may share in the opportunity of participating in all aspects of the Summer Session. Spouses/partners may live in an apartment provided by the School and also may be provided with full board in Loring Hall. Spouses/partners may also accompany the group on trips with transportation costs provided. Dependents may also be accommodated at the School; board for dependents will be offered at one-half the regular rate. The School will not offer transportation for spouses/partners and dependents to and from Greece. In order to avoid distractions to participants and directors, children under the age of 13 may not travel on overnight trips. The School will make every effort to identify quality day-care facilities and/or providers at a reasonable cost.

II. Joint Directorships

The School allows for joint applications for the directorships of the Summer Sessions. Decisions regarding dual appointments must be made at the time of application. Requests to add a joint director after the initial appointments have been made will not be approved. If a joint directorship is awarded, the two directors would share one salary. If one applicant is at a higher academic rank, then both would receive one-half of the higher stipend. The School will cover one-half of the travel expenses for each co-director. The School will offer full room and board while at the school and on trips. Spouses and dependents of co-directors cannot be accommodated because of space limitations.
