THE J. LAWRENCE ANGEL FELLOWSHIP IN HUMAN SKELETAL STUDIES

- Those Eligible:** Scholars with a Ph.D. and graduate students working on a doctoral dissertation.
- Purpose:** To allow individuals with a well-defined project, working either alone or in collaboration with local research institutions, to study human skeletal remains from archaeological contexts in Greece.
- Other Duties:** To contribute to the development of the Lab; to assist with queries from excavators; to offer a lecture on his/her project; to participate in one Regular Program School trip; and to contribute to seminars on aspects of archaeological science as part of the School's annual curriculum.
- Duration:** Academic year, beginning in September. Projects must be carefully planned for completion during this time.
- Terms:** Stipend from \$15,500 to \$27,000, depending on seniority and experience. School fees will be deducted from the fellowship stipend. Fellowship does not include travel costs, housing, board, and other living expenses.
- Application:** Submit application online at the ASCSA web site at www.ascsa.edu.gr. See attached application guidelines.
