2010 GETTY RESEARCH EXCHANGE FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM FOR THE MEDITERRANEAN BASIN AND MIDDLE EAST

The American School of Classical Studies at Athens and the Council of American Overseas Research Centers (CAORC) announce a fellowship program funded by the Getty Foundation open to Greek scholars in support of advanced regional research.

Those Eligible: Citizens of the Republic of Greece, who have already obtained a Ph.D. or have professional experience in the study or preservation of cultural heritage and who wish to undertake a specific research project at an overseas research center in another country. The fellowship program requires Greek scholars for the purposes of their research to affiliate with the overseas research center in the following countries: Algeria, Cyprus, Egypt, Israel, Italy, Jordan, Morocco, Turkey, Tunisia, and Yemen.

Duration: One to two months.

Terms: Travel and living expense stipend of up to \$4,000 for no less than one month. Maximum total fellowship award is \$4,000. All research must be completed by August 31, 2011. A final report in English must be submitted to CAORC no later than one month after completion of the fellowship tenure. Grant recipients will be paid in U.S. dollars just prior to the start of their fellowship term.

For fellows coming to the ASCSA from other countries, fees are to be paid out of the stipend by the recipient. A final report is due at the end of the award period, and the ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the relevant library of the School.

Application: Greek applicants should complete the CAORC/Getty application form posted on the ASCSA website. Submit the application, a project abstract (limit 100 words), project description with budget (limit 1,500 words), *curriculum vitae* (limit 3 pages) online at www.ascsa.edu.gr; e-mail one letter of recommendation.

Selection will be made by a scholarly review panel chosen by CAORC.
CAORC will announce the awards by April 30, 2010.
