

A codicil (YPPO/GDAPK/ARCH/B1/F42/32216/180), dated 26 April, 2004, to the Circular on the sampling and analysis of archaeological materials extends the process as related to samples taken from post-antique monuments.

Subject: Issue of permits for the analysis of archaeological material

Re.: The document (YPPO/GDAPK/ARCH/A2/F30/22268/778) of 5 March, 2004 from the Department of Greek and Foreign Scientific Foundations and Organizations and of International Issues and the Department of Applied Research of the Directorate of Conservation of Ancient and Modern Monuments.

As a supplement to the above document dealing with the granting of permissions for the sampling and analysis of archaeological material, we further stipulate that requests dealing with any samples from monuments of the Byzantine and post-Byzantine periods should be addressed to the appropriate local ephoreias of Byzantine antiquities with copies to: the Department of Applied Research of the Directorate of Conservation of Ancient and Modern Monuments, as well as to each of the two separate Departments of Greek and Foreign Scientific Foundations and Organizations and of International Issues i.e., that of the Directorate of Byzantine and post Byzantine Antiquities and that of the Directorate of Prehistoric and Classical Antiquities, in order to deal with the request in cooperation.
