## ARCHAEOLOGICAL INSTITUTE OF AMERICA ANNA C. AND OLIVER C. COLBURN FELLOWSHIP 2012-2013

**Field(s) of Study:** Classical Archaeology.

**Those Eligible:** Applicant must be citizen or permanent resident of the United States or Canada, or be actively pursuing an advanced degree at a North American college or university, must be at the pre-doctoral stage or have recently received a Ph.D. (within five years of the date of the application), and must apply concurrently to the American School for Senior Associate Membership or Student Associate Membership.

**Restrictions:** Those eligible must be accepted as either a Senior Associate Member or a Student Associate Member at the American School of Classical Studies at Athens. Members of the American School may not apply while in attendance at the School. Other major fellowships may not be held in conjunction with the Colburn. A report on use of the stipend must be submitted to the President of the AIA and to the Director of the School at the conclusion of the Fellowship term. The Fellow is expected to submit an abstract to the AIA Program Committee within two years, in accordance with that committee's guidelines, in order to present a paper on their research at the AIA Annual Meeting. The ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the Blegen Library of the School.

**Duration:** Maximum of one year.

**Terms:** Stipend of \$11,000. School fees are to be paid out of the stipend by the recipient. Fellowship does not include travel costs, housing, board, and other living expenses, see: <http://www.archaeological.org/grants/703>.

ASCSA Associate Membership application, *curriculum vitae*, and three references from persons familiar with the applicant and the applicant's work must also be completed online at [www.ascsa.edu.gr](http://www.ascsa.edu.gr). Mail transcripts to ASCSA's offices in Princeton. **Simultaneous** application to both the AIA and the American School is necessary.
