#### THE M. ALISON FRANTZ FELLOWSHIP IN POST-CLASSICAL STUDIES AT THE GENNADIUS LIBRARY 2010-2011

- Field(s) of Study:** Those represented by the Gennadius Library in Athens: Late Antiquity, Byzantine Studies, post-Byzantine Studies, or Modern Greek Studies.
- Those Eligible:** Ph.D. candidates and recent Ph.D.'s from a U.S. or Canadian institution. Successful candidates should demonstrate their need to work in the Gennadius Library. Fellows are expected to be in residence at the School for the full term of the Fellowship.
- Duration:** Commensurate with the School's academic year from September 1, 2010 to June 1, 2011.
- Terms:** A cash stipend of \$11,500 plus room, board and waiver of School fees. A final report is due at the end of the award period, and the ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the Gennadius Library of the School.
- Application:** Submit Associate Member application, *curriculum vitae*, description of the proposed project, and two letters of reference online on the ASCSA web site at [www.ascsa.edu.gr](http://www.ascsa.edu.gr).
