

CORINTH: COINS, 1925–1926

THE THEATER DISTRICT AND THE ROMAN VILLA

(PLATES 17–21)

FROM 1925 TO 1930 T. Leslie Shear, Sr. undertook excavations in the general area of the Theater at Old Corinth (Fig. 1). Some 13,500 coins were found in the course of this operation,¹ but they were not included in the general numismatic monograph, *Corinth VI*. Most of the coins were cleaned, and a good many identified and utilized by Dr. Shear in his preliminary reports in the *AJA* and by Richard Stillwell in the final publication of the Theater.² Over the intervening years this material saw the attention of such numismatists as Agnes Baldwin Brett, Josephine P. Shear, K. E. Askew, George C. Miles, David F. Metcalf, and Joan Fisher. The intended publication of these finds³ did not come to pass, with the exception of two hoards,⁴ comprising between them less than a hundred pieces. During World War II the field records associated with the Theater material were mostly lost, and subsequently the coins became subdivided in the Corinth Museum coin room.

In the summer of 1983 Charles K. Williams, II invited me to begin the process of bringing these coins to general notice by modernizing the references and converting the surviving records to the format of the present excavations at Corinth. The coins presented in this article are those which were found in 1925 and 1926. They come from the main Theater excavations, the adjacent trench then believed to be within the Sanctuary of Athena Chalinitis (Athena Trench), and from the salvage excavation at a Roman villa about a kilometer distant, on the way to Sikyon (Roman Villa).⁵ Additionally, there were also included here about a dozen coins deriving from such diverse locations as the Hadji Mustapha fountain, Peirene, the Odeum, and the Agora. The circumstances under which these coins came to be included in the Shear material are not recorded either at the American School or in the Corinthian archives.

The high degree of at least partial legibility of the 1925 lot is not typical of excavation material either at Corinth or elsewhere. The surviving records suggest that anywhere from

several dozens to several hundred additional pieces were initially recovered but were then culled from the main series as too badly preserved for identification or too modern to be of interest. I was able to locate two small parcels of this class, one mainly of Turkish and modern Greek pieces, the other of mostly illegible or problematic types. These have been reunited with the main body in excavation sequence, and although others are clearly unaccounted for, I feel little of interest has escaped.

As a body these coins should best be compared with the finds recorded in *Corinth VI* and *Hesperia* 10, 1941, since they derive, in the main, from the upper levels of their respective areas at Corinth:

The principal difference between the Shear material and that of the other areas is the higher proportion of Greek issues; Dr. Broneer, supervising the Athena Trench for Dr. Shear, the other finds show, reached Greek levels in 1925 and 1926.

CONSPECTUS

The 2554 pieces published here show a number of variants, very rare or unknown types, particularly in the Corinthian and Peloponnesian Imperials of the Severan period. We have evidence for the first time for the long held opinion⁶ that the Corinthian *tesserae* were early Imperial in the form of an overstrike on an early Duoviral issue. Among the Roman and Byzantine issues are a few unrecorded *officina* marks that will require "pen and ink" changes in the standard catalogues but no new major varieties. In the Byzantine series there are several interesting overstrikes, particularly in the Anonymous Folles, most notably the strike of Rodger Borsa on a Class K Anonymous issue. All remarkable pieces are commented upon in the notes following the catalogue.

Review of this group as a whole has suggested some broad themes that deserve more attention than can be here permitted but which should be brought to wider notice.

Our lot, like almost every batch of Corinthian excavation coins, shows numbers of the Corinthian Pegasos/Trident bronzes from contexts that are undoubtedly Roman. Long since,⁷ the seemingly improbable suggestion had been made that, for some time after Laus Julia's foundation, her citizens used the old autonomous issues as a base copper unit. Harris, in a later endorsement⁸ of what was surely a rare numismatic phenomenon, included the idea that Corinth saw low-level occupation during the century between her sack and the Caesarian refoundation. It was thought that by such a medium the old bronze would have been transmitted to the colonists. I doubt the coin finds themselves require such.⁹ Almost

from the inception of bronze coinage in the Peloponnese there appears to have been an economic *koinon* where the small bronze units were concerned: from Argos to Pellene the coins of Corinth, Sikyon, Phlius, Argos, and, more rarely, Kleone and Pellene, circulated side by side. The destruction of Corinth did not change that system; her coins continued to circulate in the broader region, to be reintroduced after the colony's founding, when also came most, if not all, of the relatively few Greek issues struck between 146 and 45 B.C. that have been found in the Corinth excavations. Although there is instinctive resistance to a circulating life of this length for minor bronze, it should be remembered that dozens of 200–300-year-old nummi were circulating in Sardis at the time of her destruction in the 7th century after Christ,¹⁰ most of which were much less substantial and less well made than the typical Pegasus/Trident.

The appearance of a significant number of Corinthian Imperials of Septimius Severus and his family, including some new and very rare types, occasions a fresh look at the Severan issues as a whole and the question of the end of minting at Roman Corinth. Conventional wisdom has it that this series ends with Caracalla or Geta [sic].¹¹ In fact, all the Corinthian Severan issues appear to be lifetime products of Septimius, none later than A.D. 205, with the marriage issues of Caracalla and Plautilla of 203 quite likely being the final strikings. There are no coins of Geta as Augustus. None of Septimius' obverse legends reflect the epithet "PIVS", which he and Caracalla assumed at Rome in 201, and it is quite rare in the latter's signatures. All Caracalla's portraits are extremely youthful, and, finally, the coinage of Plautilla exceeds that of Julia Domna both in absolute numbers and varieties of reverse. All these facts are highly indicative of a series that ended very early in the 3rd century after Christ.

The existence of one or more provincial mints in Greece under Alexius I and Manuel Comnenus has been accepted for some time,¹² and the fact that this class of bronze dominates the finds at Corinth is well known.¹³ Inspection of the several hundred examples of this class present in our group would suggest that there is sufficient variation in weight, fabric, detail, and style to suppose that, for at least the Monogram issue of Manuel, there were several such mints. One must, in all probability, have been at Corinth, and another series can readily be assigned to Athens. Thebes is quite likely as another, while still another, unknown, mint is also contributing to the total. A detailed study of this bronze, so important to Greece for a century, is forthcoming.

COIN LOSS PATTERNS

The loss of the major part of the field records documenting the bulk of the coins discussed here prevents much specific application to the monuments from which they derive. They

are, however, numerous enough and from a sufficiently restricted area that some use may be made of them nonetheless. As evidence from an outlying district, they may be compared with the over-all picture given in *Corinth VI* and *Hesperia* 6 and 10, material deriving, in the main, from the center of the city. Above we have noted the over-all similarity in the broad sense of the relative percentages of Greek, Roman, and Byzantine issues, but on the finer level there are a few ripples that demand attention.

The number of Severan issues from the Athena Trench is extraordinarily high (2 certain, 2 probable Imperials, 24 certain and 4 probable Corinthian and other Greek Imperials), fully half as numerous as coins from all sources of the previous century from both the Athena Trench and the Theater combined. This total also nearly doubles that of the recovered pieces from the 50 years following A.D. 205, again combining the Theater with the Athena Trench. An event of considerable importance, it would seem, ought to be placed in the second half of the first decade of the 3rd century after Christ for this area, if not for Corinth as a whole.¹⁴ Whether it was a major building program that raised the relative coin-loss rate or some catastrophe is not immediately clear. The only similar concentration of Severan material at Corinth came from the 1933 excavation of a structure south of the excavation house. This area is also on the town periphery; Edwards explained the character of the deposit in terms of the building's function,¹⁵ although her reasoning does not account for the distinctly Severan make-up. Since coins of the first half of the 3rd century are scarce generally at Corinth, I am inclined to think a disaster of some sort occurred that affected the city as a whole. The date is indicated by the peripheral deposits, and the cessation of minting at Corinth is quite likely related to this event as well.

There is an anomalous pattern to coin loss in the third quarter of the 4th century after Christ in the Athena Trench—Theater district. We have recovered 20 coins of Gratian, 12 of Valens, and 11 of Valentinian I. These figures are contrary to the loss pattern of Corinth center and, indeed, of the Eastern Empire as a whole. At all major sites the issues of Valens regularly outnumber those of Valentinian I, sometimes by twice or more, while those of Gratian are invariably a distant third.¹⁶ Together with this phenomenon must be placed the sharp peak in our material in the years A.D. 351–361. Coins of Constantius II, Constantius Gallus, and Julian Caesar, of these years, are routinely among the most common 4th-century excavation finds, outnumbering the issues of the previous two decades sometimes by twice. Our totals are nearer three times that figure. On the other hand, the period following Julian's succession shows a radical drop in the coin-loss rate that holds until the death of

Valens, whereafter it returns to figures more typical for Corinth. Some event, it would seem, affected the periphery of the city in the five-year period centered on the last year of Julian's sole reign. The message of the finds of the house of Valentinian is that the district was about a decade in recovering. The great seismic event of 365 or a local disaster a year or two later would be prime candidates. It was possibly the same event that caused the final abandonment of the Demeter Sanctuary on the slopes of Acrocorinth.¹⁷

This same pattern may be seen in the last years of the 4th century. As Professor Grierson noted,¹⁸ both *Corinth VI* and *Hesperia* 10 are misleading in their tabular listings of the coins of Arcadius. The vast majority of the common finds of this emperor date to the lifetime of his father, both in our area and in the center of Corinth. About half of the much less common issues of Honorius are lifetime products of Theodosius as well. Thus we again have a tall peak of coins representing issues up to A.D. 395 and a radical drop in the loss rate for the decades thereafter. Here, the Gothic sack of Corinth in 395/6 is an even more likely reason for the phenomenon.

The numismatic evidence would have it that neither Corinth nor the Theater recovered for a century (the Athena Trench area, apparently, not until the 10th century). For the Theater, now a city dump, the 6th century shows a steady increase in finds up to the reign of Justin II. It is interesting to note that the onslaught of the Slavs did not produce the same radical "peak-valley" effect in the finds here, nor in those of Corinth generally: if Corinth was taken by the Slavs, she must have sustained little damage and almost immediately been returned to Imperial control. Sharply contrasting is the fate of the Late Roman farming community at Nemea,¹⁹ where a sharp peak under Justin II is followed by near total numismatic silence for more than four hundred years. What our finds indicate, rather, is a steady decline in the late 6th and 7th centuries, with a brief flurry occasioned by Constans II's passage to the West, to extinction in the third quarter of the 7th century.

However much the volume of coinage was reduced during the period, the Theater district appears to have been out of use from about 675 to 885, since only a single coin can be assigned to that range from our material. This region was, perhaps, not even within the boundaries of a shrunken Corinth. Harris²⁰ placed the beginnings of the revival of a monetary economy in the city to the reign of Theophilus (A.D. 829–842). Our evidence from the Theater district points to the reign of Leo VI (A.D. 886–912). This is consistent with a gradual recovery for the city in the 9th century.²¹ Renewed activity would reach an outlying area about a generation after the process began in the more desirable areas of the city center.

The next instance of the "peak-valley" effect in the Theater district occurred under Manuel Comnenus and probably reflects the injury done the city by Rodger of Sicily. Total

abandonment of the area does not seem to have begun, however, until the removal of the Prince of Achaea from Corinth to his new capital at Clarentia. The decline seems gradual in the later 13th and early 14th centuries, but when the Venetians arrived, the district had been uninhabited for about a century. Their coming initiated a low level of activity that has persisted down to the present day.

As more of the coins from the Theater district are published we may be able to refine the history of the area more closely; it is plain from the summary table (p. 157) that the finds even from neighboring areas of Corinth like the Theater and the Athena Trench can, at various periods, vary markedly, one from another.

NOTES

The larger-size autonomous bronze of Corinth

The incidence of these intermittently issued doubles to the Pegasos/Trident suggests that, while they are certainly not common, they are not so rare as their relative numbers in *Corinth VI* and the standard catalogues would seem to indicate. These larger pieces had their analogues in the "larger" Doves of Sikyon and in the slightly more common doubles of Phlius.

Illegible Greek fabric

Almost all these pieces are of the module of and thickness appropriate to the Corinthian Pegasos/Trident, and some were so identified by earlier examination. The ravages of bronze disease prevent confirmation, but those pieces so deemed are listed individually.

Hoard

A group of seven coins was found together in the Theater, either directly touching or just along side one another. There was no trace of a container. The composition of the group (two Nicephorus III, one Anonymous Follis Class H, two Anonymous Follis Class I, and two early Thessalonica-mint tetrartera of Alexius I) would be suitable for a dropped change purse of the last decade of the 11th century.

Cut-down 11th-century folles

More than a dozen specimens of the Anonymous series, an issue of Nicephorus III, and some two dozen earlier issues of Alexius I (both pre- and post-reform) are cut down to the module of the typical half tetarteron of the 12th century. It would be tempting to place this second use of these coins in the reign of John II, while the supply of coin from the local Greek mints was suspended. While well supplied under both Alexius I and Manuel I, Corinth must have been seriously short of small change in the later years of John. An alternative location for this group would be the later years of Manuel, after the Norman disruption of the provincial mint system.

The Latin “Imitative” Series

Edwards did not separate the Latin “Imitative” series from their prototypes in *Corinth VI*, but inspection shows that the majority of her pieces between nos. 156 and 177 are of this class. That the small module series belongs to Greece, as shown by Hendy, pp. 213–214, is further confirmed by our specimens. Moreover, the abrupt end of Byzantine Imperial coinage here (only eight examples later than Manuel I) contrasted with the flurry of Frankish and contemporary European coins of the earlier 13th century (more than fifty examples) point us toward a western origin.

The Late Colonial and Modern coin finds

Edwards did not elect to include coins in *Corinth VI* later than A.D. 1500 (p. 1). Harris remarked that the very low numbers of such in her compilations (*Hesperia* 10, p. 162) suggested that the migration of the city center to its current location be placed in the late Venetian or early Turkish times. In fact, these late coins are fairly common among the finds from the old Roman center, somewhat less so in the Theater district, and are evidence in both areas for steady occupation from just before the Turkish conquest down to the present day.

18. 25-444 The last two examples here, in contrast to the first and the *Corinth VI* specimens of this issue, show that the I in PAMPHILO can either be the last character in line four of the reverse inscription or the first in line five.
20. 25-58 This combination of obverse and reverse types is appropriate to C. Heius Pollio's earlier duovirate with C. Heius Pamphilus (Ed. 34), suggesting a very close interval between the magistracies.
26. 26-1400 See also Nos. 132 (26-1398) and 192 (26-1399). These three coins were found fused together. They may offer some evidence for the thesis advanced in the general commentary on the use by the early colonists of old autonomous bronze (pp. 98–99 above).
29. 26-792 The variety is in the direction of Pegasos' flight, here left rather than right as in the *BMC* and *Corinth VI* citations.
50. 25-541 This coin is roughly twice the size of its companion with identical type.
57. 25-233 The coin is illegible, but the portrait is that of Hadrian. The type is common for Domitian (Ed. 106).
68. 25-532 The reverse type is known for Commodus (*NCP*, p. 21, no. 20).
69. 25-232 Obverse inscription variant: MAVR[COMMODVS ANTON[.
72. 25-319 Unpublished. A second example is in the trays of the Corinth excavations.
76. 25-306 The reverse type is known for Caracalla (*BMC Corinth*, p. 88, no. 663).
77. 26-261 The reverse type is known for Marcus Aurelius (*NCP*, pl. B:V).
78. 25-251 The reverse type is known for Geta (Ed. 225).

79. 25-382 The obverse type is known from Ed. 200. The reverse is given by Mionnet (M.S., p. 104, no. 693) for Lucius Verus; it is one half of the sculptural group represented on *BMC Corinth*, p. 80, no. 620.
80. 26-207 The irregular obverse legend [IVLIA]ΔΟ[M]NASENNTE is duplicated by Corinth coin 66-553.
83. 25-389 The reverse type is known for Plautilla (Ed. 217).
84. 26-719 Together with 26-168 (No. 90), one of the infrequent types struck for all four of the senior members of the Severan house (Julia Domna, Ed. 194; Septimius, *NCP*, pl. C: XXXVI).
85. 25-355 The reverse type is known for Antoninus Pius (*NCP*, pl. E:LXXXII).
90. 26-168 See above, note on No. 84.
123. 25-407 The actual form of the reverse device is Σ , but style and module make this the most likely class.
132. 26-1398 See above, note on No. 26.
144. 25-641 The left-hand and center statues are clearly the Artemis Laphria of Patrai and the Aphrodite of Acrocorinth. These two alone appear on coins of Patrai under Commodus (*BMC Peloponnesus*, p. 28, no. 40). The third statue may be the Athena of Troizen (*NCP*, pl. M:III).
148. 25-776a The reverse type is known for Caracalla (*BMC Peloponnesus*, p. 32, no. 16).
152. 25-518 The variety consists in the distribution of the letters in the second line of the reverse inscription: here ΔΑΙ Θ MO; *BMC* ΔΑ Θ IMO.
164. 25-352 The reverse type is known for Julia Domna (*BMC Peloponnesus*, p. 152, no. 170).
165. 26-63 The reverse type is known for Julia Domna (Ed. 416).
168. 25-512 This coin, although the ethnic is lost, should be given to Argos. The candidates in Greece, owing to the reverse type, are limited to Argos, Delphi, and Nikopolis. Delphi does not seem to have struck under Severus, and Nikopolis' agonistic type was established and constant from the early Roman period. This type is paralleled at Argos by an issue for Julia Domna (*BMC Peloponnesus*, p. 152, no. 171).
169. 25-107 The reverse type is known for Julia Domna (Ed. 145).
170. 25-333, 26-905 In *NCP* mistakenly given in the plates to Pagai; same as *NCP*, p. 42, no. 30(5).
179. 25-359 The reverse type is known for Geta (*BMC Peloponnesus*, p. 63, no. 4).
188. 26-135 The type is known for Antoninus Pius (*SNGCop* 553).
189. 26-1438 Most likely the core of a plated hemi-obol.
192. 26-1399 See above, note on No. 26.
229. 25-448 Obverse inscription variant: M COMMODVS ANTONINVS AV[G PIV]S.
263. 25-740k The form of the obverse inscription, IMPCCLAVRE[.], is unrecorded and is probably a die-sinker's error.
264. 25-301 The portrait is unusually fine and shows the balteus looped over the emperor's left shoulder.
- 25-673 The emperor's armor is atypically rendered, showing Persian-style chain mail instead of the normal cuirass.
290. 25-299 The reverse legend is appropriate to *RIC V*, ii, no. 181.
318. 25-446 There is no field symbol apparent. The coin is in good condition.

323. 25-47 *RIC VII* questioned the short obverse legend for this mint mark. Here it is confirmed.
See *RIC VII*, p. 400, note 51.
334. 25-674 See the note to no. 190 in *RIC VIII*: this piece clearly shows the jeweled altar for officina S.
380. 25-675 The form of the H in the mint mark is clearly N, but the obverse inscription, CRIS[PVS] NOB CAES, is unknown for Nikomedea.
401. 25-729 The officina letter has the form Λ. See the discussion in *RIC VIII*, p. 411 for its proper interpretation.
407. 25-744 This officina is not recorded in *RIC VIII*.
412. 26-518a This officina is not recorded in *RIC VIII*.
415. 25-726 This combination of reverse inscription, GLORIA EXERCITVS *, and mint mark SMK is recorded in *RIC VIII* only for Constans, but a companion piece for Constantius II, as here, was to be expected.
426. 26-759 The engraving of the reverse inscription is very poor, with I for S in the mint mark and for E in the legend. All other features indicate a regular issue.
446. 26-1023 This mint mark is not recorded in *RIC VIII*: 
464. 26-1119 Obverse legend garbled: DN[. . . .]VSNOBIBLE.
471. 26-967 This officina is not recorded in *RIC IX*.
553. 25-588 A nearly centered obverse brockage.
589. 26-1475 An obverse brockage.
592. 25-537 Imitates Claudius II (*RIC V*, i, p. 219, no. 109).
599. 26-48 A very rare piece but here confirmed.
602. 26-726 This officina in this year is known only from a British Museum addition.
616. 25-70 The form of the regnal date Η is not recorded. Although both the imperial signature and the mint mark are lost, the weight and module of the denomination place it here.
645. 25-95 This specimen has a variant rendering of the reverse inscription: the end of the emperor's name should be the first letter of the second line. It was either omitted in error or was the last letter in line one, here off flan.
649. 25-735 This find is the furthest from Cherson that this issue has been archaeologically recovered, to the best of my knowledge.
660. 25-664 This unusual mis-strike seems to show, contrary to established belief, that it was the Cross on Steps that was the anvil die of this issue, not the Christ portrait.
679. 26-370 A curious double strike: an obverse brockage, but the proper reverse is faintly visible.
684. 25-159, 25-647 Monogram form , mint of Thebes or Thessalonica.
- 25-341, 25-646 Monogram form , uncertain Greek mint.
- 25-430 Monogram form , mint of Athens.
- 25-669, 26-164 Monogram form , mint of Corinth.
- 26-320 As 25-669 but no pellet in the lambda, mint of Corinth.

685. 26-253 This coin has been overstruck by an uncertain type but so weakly that it is this type of Manuel that is most evident.
700. 26-204 The Bendall Type 10 Follis (S. Bendall, "The Mint of Trebizond under Alexis I and the Gabrades," *NC*, ser. 7, 17, 1977 [pp. 126–136], p. 134) has not been previously found in Central/Southern Greece. Bendall's theory about the isolation of Trebizond after the issue of Type 9 is thus further eroded (*idem*, "Some Further Notes on the Mint of Trebizond under Alexis I," *NC*, ser. 7, 19, 1979, p. 211).
756. 26-1450 The reverse of the Augustan(?) Duoviral issue has been hammered flat, and the typical Pegasos of tessera type Ed. 231 struck on the obverse. Because that die was appreciably smaller, the older type is still quite evident.


