- Field of Study:** Archaeology.
- Those Eligible:** Students in the U.S. or Israel, who are Ph.D. candidates writing their dissertations in archaeology or recent Ph.D.'s completing a project, such as the revision of a dissertation for publication, which requires a lengthy residence in Greece.
- Terms:** Cash stipend of \$11,500 plus room, board and waiver of fees. A final report is due at the end of the award period, and the ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the Blegen Library of the School.
- Duration:** Commensurate with the School's academic year, September to early June.
- Application:** Submit application for Associate Membership to the School, *curriculum vitae*, detailed description of the project pursued in Greece, and three letters of recommendation online at the ASCSA web site at www.ascsa.edu.gr. Transcripts of record should be submitted to:
