KRESS PUBLICATION FELLOWSHIPS 2012-2013

The American School of Classical Studies at Athens is pleased to announce the fourth year of a five-year program of fellowships funded by the Samuel H. Kress Foundation. These Fellowships are aimed at supporting scholars who are assigned studies for publication from the School's excavations at Ancient Corinth or the Athenian Agora. The Kress Foundation supports research in the art and architecture of antiquity.

Eligibility: Senior (post-doctoral) scholars working on a Corinth or Agora publication assignment. Preference will be given to those working on a Corinth or Agora excavation volume and to applicants who have not previously received the Kress Publications Fellowship. Applications from current staff of the School are not eligible.

Terms: A total of \$30,000 is available for each grant cycle, defined as the School's fiscal year (July 1 – June 30). The School awards up to three or more grants each cycle. Grants are for a minimum of three months (up to \$10,000) to a maximum of nine months (up to \$30,000). School fees, travel costs, housing, board, and other living expenses are to be paid out of the stipend by the recipient. A final report and budget are due at the end of the award period, and the ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the Blegen Library of the School.

Application: ASCSA Associate Member application; *curriculum vitae*; proposal statement including project outline, explanation of goals, statement of the significance of the project, work completed to date, schedule for completion, and budget; letter of support from the appropriate excavation's director; and two letters of recommendation. Applicants are encouraged to include costs for any photography needed for final publication. Submit all application materials online on the ASCSA web site at www.ascsa.edu.gr.
