PAUL REHAK MEMORIAL TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP 2009-2010

TRAVEL GRANTS FOR RESEARCH IN GREECE

Those Eligible: Regular Members and Student Associate members already attending the School for the entire 2009-2010 academic year.

Purpose: To allow individuals to travel in Greece to conduct a research project during the 2009-2010 academic year from September 1, 2009 to July 1, 2010. Preference is given to those who have not received funding for travel from their home institutions or other sources.

Terms: Grant of \$1,000 or grants of lesser amounts. Any applicable School fees are to be paid out of the fellowship stipend by the recipient. Fellowship does not include costs for School trips, housing or board at the School. In addition, it is not meant to cover travel costs to and from Greece. A final report is due at the end of the award period, and the ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the relevant library of the School.

Application: Submit application, *curriculum vitae*, project description (up to 2,000 words), and budget online on the ASCSA web site at www.ascsa.edu.gr.
