SOLOW DISSERTATION RESEARCH FELLOWSHIPS 2009-2010

Program funded by The Solow Art & Architecture Foundation for advanced Ph.D. candidates to use the resources of the American School of Classical Studies at Athens and to travel in Greece for dissertation research.

Eligibility: Ph.D. candidates from North American institutions in the advanced stages of research on doctoral dissertations related to the art, architecture, and archaeology of ancient Greece, requiring the use of the ASCSA resources and archaeological sites and collections in Greece. The Solow Fellowship may not be held concurrently with another School fellowship.

Terms: Funding for travel and living expenses for up to two months in Greece, with a maximum amount of \$1,500 per month. The Solow Dissertation Research Fellowship will not be awarded more than once to the same person. A final report is due at the end of the award period, and the ASCSA expects that copies of all publications that result from research conducted as a Fellow of the ASCSA be contributed to the Blegen Library of the School and to The Solow Art & Architecture Foundation.

Duration: For up to two months for the period from June 1, 2009 to May 31, 2010.

Application: Submit the application, *curriculum vitae*, a three-page description of the project to be pursued in Greece (including budget and disclosing additional sources of funding), stating reasons why research needs to be performed in Greece or at the ASCSA, and a letter of support from the dissertation advisor online on the ASCSA web site at www.ascsa.edu.gr.
