Policy on Facilities and Administrative / Indirect Costs for Fellowships

Purpose

This policy establishes the American School of Classical Studies at Athens position regarding Facilities and Administrative costs, also known as indirect costs, on fellowships awarded by the School.

Policy Statement

The American School of Classical Studies at Athens does not disburse Facilities and Administrative costs on fellowships. All fellowship funds awarded must be applied directly to support the fellow's academic activities, including stipend, housing when applicable, and approved research expenses. No portion of fellowship funds may be allocated to institutional overhead, administrative fees, or indirect cost recovery.

Scope

This policy applies to all fellowships awarded by the American School of Classical Studies at Athens, regardless of fund source, recipient classification, or program duration.

Compliance

All proposals, budgets, and financial transactions connected to fellowship funding must adhere to this policy.

Effective Date

This policy shall remain in force until amended or rescinded.
